A mezzo-soprano, Ms. Hall sings with Bel Canto Company of Greensboro and has performed with the Charlotte Symphony Orchestra, Charlotte Repertory Orchestra, Oratorio Singers and Oratorio Chamber Singers of Charlotte, Piedmont Chambers Singers, Columbia and August Choral Societies. A North Carolina Regional Artist, Ms. Hall was a Fellow at the 2001 Conductor's Institute of South Carolina. She completed the Choral Music Experience Program under Cheryl Dupont, Director New Orleans Children's Choir.
